Badrinath a soft ware engineer, who is brother of Kalyan and just started his career and got recently married, shared this information with abhaya:

Mr.Kalyan met with an accident and hit by an auto rickshaw on 15 July 2010. (It was a hit and run case). He is presently undergoing treatment at Sunshine Hospital, Hyderabad for Ace tabular fracture since 18 July 2010. The operation has been performed to his hip joint and fitted the broken bones with the help of steel rods and screws.

He was sitting in the front seat along with driver in a sharing auto and a fast moving auto from the opposite side hit him on the right leg there by fracturing his HIP joint, he could not move and his friends who were accompanying him in the same auto came to his rescue. He was immediately taken to Dr. Srikanth Reddy at Guntakal town and as the case was critical and emergency he referred to the case to Dr Guruva Reddy, Hyderabad.

Kalyan was brought to Sunshine Hospital Hyderabad in an ambulance immediately. The doctor suggested that he has to be operated immediately and advised the family members to admit him. The normal X-ray image could not show the detailed fracture. The injury severity was diagnosed only after taking 3D CT Scan at Vijaya Diagnostic Center, Himayathnagar.



The estimated cost of the operation and hospitalization charges are beyond Rs 2,00,000/- This is a burden for the family as they are already had lot of debts to be cleared on account of father's knees operation which costed Rs 4,50,000 (Rs 2,00,000 was reimbursed by Medical policy and the rest was borne by me) in the year 2008. Further during 2007 we had the responsibility of performing the marriage of my only sister. At present we have no medical insurance coverage for supporting him. Now i must take all the responsibilities of my family because I am the sole earning member. My brother's income is very minimal and insufficient since he is a tailor. My mother and father are old and depend upon me both of them are non earning members. I have some savings with me to the tune of Rs.25,000/- and I requested my close friends and all of them very caringly pooled Rs.40,000/- in support of my brother. Further it has been said that the recovery time for Mr. Kalyan would be around 24 months and he cannot go ahead with his existing tailoring work, as his right side hip is injured.

It would be great if abhaya can stand by my side in facing this difficult situation and if god permit me to become ok with financial situation, I would also be part of abhaya in doing good work to those who are in similar conditions like me.
