## CSR Update



### CSR spend may grow over 4 times to \$2.5 billion: Study

Spending by Indian companies on corporate social responsibility (CSR) activities can grow more than four

times to USD 2.5 billion (over Rs 15,000 crore) a year if all companies spend the funds as per the norms.

The total spending on CSR initiatives stood at USD 600 million in the 2012-13 fiscal, while almost half was accounted for by top 10 entities including RIL, Coal India, Tata Steel and SBI. These funds were spent by the companies on various social initiatives of the government and NGOs.

Analysis of CSR activities of top 100 companies shows that the mode of giving has primarily been through NGOs and other social organizations as around 90 per cent companies are channeling their funds through these organizations.

"While majority of companies have established in-house foundations to engage in social activities, around 10 per cent of the organizations choose to design and execute activities directly through them," the report said.

Besides providing monetary assistance, companies are now also beginning to show greater degree of involvement in social initiatives like volunteering and providing expertise on best practices to NGOs.

### CSR doesn't end with monetary contribution:


Corporate social responsibility (CSR) isn't just companies' monetary contribution to society, but also includes efforts made for social reformation, explained Prerana Langa, chief executive officer of Yes Foundation, the CSR wing of Yes Bank. At a session on 'CSR: Naming the Big Elephant', organized as part of Development Dialogue-2015 here on Sunday, Langa said CSR has a broader agenda of making each individual of a corporate company play a key role in social transformation.

Deepa Reddy, vice-president of the CSR wing of Apollo Hospitals Group, clarified that companies do not necessarily form a CSR wing just to comply with the law. "One should not forget that many companies have real concerns for society and wish to serve it with a real passion," she explained.

Birger Stamperdahl, CEO of Give2Asia, said city corporations and corporate houses should join hands to bridge the gap between the provider and the needy.

Responding to a question, Langa said irrespective of the model of business, any company can take up social work.

Reddy made it clear that corporate tie-ups with non-profit organizations should not pose a challenge to the utilization of CSR funds. "A partnership is a must. Many organizations wish to have partnerships with corporate companies and nothing is wrong with it."

Environmental Engineering Research Institute (NEERI), the expert committee formed by the Bombay high court held a meeting on Thursday to discuss utilization of funds of corporate social responsibility (CSR) for a green Kumbh mela.

"Every company is doing social work but in a scattered manner. What the HC expects and what the NEERI recommended should come under one roof. The HC has asked the committee to bring everyone together," said Rajesh Pandit, a member of the green kumbh committee and environmental activist.

The recommendations included regular events on the banks of the river for two years, national/international-level seminars by well-known personalities, making short films and showing them in schools, competitions in schools on environment awareness, collection of plastic by school children and sending them to the plants at Sinnar/Malegaon for recycling, making cloth bags, cleanliness drive such as collecting nirmalya, making and distributing dustbins, making bio-degradable eco-friendly toilets at various locations and rejuvenating the kunds in Trimbakeshwar.

The recommendations also include massive tree plantation in the catchment areas, phytoid treatment for curbing river pollution and providing high resolution CCTV cameras for keeping vigil on activities that pollute the river during Kumbh mela.

## Uninor's project Sampark recognized as best social initiative at Greentech CSR gold award

Uninor, the 100% subsidiary of Norway-based Telenor Group, has been acknowledged for 'outstanding achievement in corporate social responsibility' in the service sector. The company has been bestowed upon with the 4th Greentech Annual CSR Award 2015 in the gold category for Project Sampark, an initiative aimed at bridging the mobile gender gap in rural areas of India. The award was presented at a ceremony held at Kolkata on January 29.

Project Sampark aims to address the socio-economic causes behind the mobile gender gap and increase women's access to mobile phones in the rural areas of India. A Uninor study done by the research firm GFK in the Aligarh district of Uttar Pradesh revealed that the incidence of mobile phone usage was significantly higher among males - 76 men out of 100 owned a mobile phone while only 29 women out of 100 owned one. The project uses innovative product and unique distribution model to make easy and hassle free mobile services available amongst rural women. It looked at approaching the barriers to mobile adoption through a two-pronged strategy to address key barriers like cost, culture, technical literacy and perception of values, which discourages women to adopt mobile telecommunication services.





## Government panel to suggest ways to monitor CSR works

The government has set up a high level panel to suggest a framework to assess CSR activities done by corporates under the companies law. The high level committee would work on a framework for

assessing the CSR works, including money spent on such activities, by corporates. The panel, headed by former Home Secretary Anil Bajjal, would have members from industry and academia, among others. The report of the panel is expected in six months.

In December, Corporate Affairs Minister Arun Jaitley said the government has taken a decision "in principle to constitute a high level committee to suggest measures for proper assessment and progress of CSR initiatives by companies including government companies". Going by estimates, about Rs 14,000 crore is expected to be spent towards CSR activities by companies in the current fiscal.

## Samsung India contributes Rs 2.92 crore to PM National Relief Fund

Samsung India has contributed Rs 2.92 crore to the Prime Minister's National Relief Fund. The cheque was handed over to the Prime Minister's Office by Hyun Woo Bang, senior VP and chief relations officer of Samsung India and Dipesh Shah, senior VP and deputy MD of Samsung Research India-Bangalore. The contribution is a part of Samsung's ongoing CSR activities through which the company aims to create positive change for people across the world. Samsung also expressed its desire to participate in the 'Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao' scheme initiated at the behest of the Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Last year, the company donated Rs 3 crore to the Prime Minister's National Relief Fund to aid relief operations in flood-hit Jammu and Kashmir.



## CSR spending may not touch Rs 20,000 crore mark

CSR spending touch the projected spending of Rs 20,000 crore as has been reported ever since the new law enacted in last April 2014 mandating companies to spend 2% of their profit on CSR. As the year draws close on this April 1, 2015 , we will know the exact amount of spending. According to the insiders in the industry, the figure may not reach anywhere close to the projected Rs 20,000 crore. It is expected to be just one third of what is projected, observed many CSR Professionals who have assembled in Kolkata at a Greentech Foundation's two day national meet on Sustainability & CSR for Inclusive Growth . 70 per cent of these 16352 companies are not so large is the reason cited by some of the professionals, for the CSR Spend to be around Rs 5000 crore.

According to Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs, around 16,352 companies fall within the purview of Section 135 of the Companies Act. Around 20,000 crore in total will be spent by Corporates each year on CSR. Around 30,000 Directors of Boards will be directly involved.

The CSR Roll Out also demands a large number of CSR Professionals. Nowhere in the world available are qualified CSR Professionals. We need 30,000 CSR Professionals in India . Hence Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs is offering a 9 months online training program. It was the world's first Professional Course being offered by us on CSR. The first batch of 200 trained CSR professionals will be out into the market this July, Bhaskar Chatterjee, DG & CEO of Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs(IICA), Govt of India informed.

Currently there are approximately 3.3 million registered NGOs in India. Probably around ten lakh fully functional and ready to face implementation challenges are available. The average absorptive capacity of NGOs is around Rs 20 lakh annually. Hence, around 1,00,000(one lakh) NGOs are required at the vert least to carry forward CSR agenda in the country, observed Bhasker Chatterjee.

Adding further Chatterjee stated that we need to create an NGO Hub which will, inter alia empanel credible implementing agencies. Need to create a shelf of projects from which companies and implementing agencies may choose.

On the day two, the man behind the CSR, Bhaskar Chatterjee, DG & CEO of Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs(IICA), Govt of India addressed the gathering of 200 strong CSR and Environment experts and he also moderated a Panel Discussion on CSR Opportunities and Challenges.. Speaking on the occasion he said, 16000companies out of 6 lakh registered companies in India who fall under the new legislation will file their first ever CSR Report in two months from now . That will give us the macro view of the entire CSR initiative in the country. CSR is the new game changer.

Once the reports were posted on the websites of the respective companies and submitted to the IICA by this

April, we will compile all those reports and submit the macro view of the same to the Ministry and Parliament, informed Bhaskar Chatterjee.

Speaking further he gave clarifications on lot of ambiguities, doubts in the minds of the CSR professionals. He said companies need not do CSR activities in and around their manufacturing and production centres. They can implement their CSR projects anywhere tin India. In India only 16% of total industries are into manufacturing sector and remaining 84% is non manufacturing. Hence this flexibility. They can carry out their CSR projects wherever they want within India. First year is crucial,. We don't expect all the companies to spend the mandated 2%. If so they need to write an explanation to the ministry. The suggested areas of activities under the schedule 7 of the law also broadened. Three new areas Urban Slum Development, Swachch Bharath and Clean Ganga Project are added recently he said. The companies who do not comply with the rules laid down in the law may face severe punishment, he said.

Chatterjee is also clarified that what is CSR and What is not. Any CSR activity which is not rupee measurable is not a CSR Activity. Those activities which do not benefit the poor and backward sections of the community are not CSR activities. The benefits extended to employees will not count as CSR. Funds/moneys deposited in Central or Government accounts will not count as CSR. . Government Programs and Initiatives shouldn't be duplicated. Those can be complimented and or supplemented. Also the programs or projects undertaken outside India will not count as part of CSR Projects, Chatterjee said. Pure philanthropy or mere donations are no longer counted as CSR. he informed to the packed audience. Also those activities which are in compliance with any regulation or law will not be treated as CSR project. - **CS Kiran Kumar Gupta**

Gulberga which is a draught prone area and 90% of the population is depending on agriculture for their lively hood that too they depend on seasonal rains, but the area is backward with scanty rainfall and has dry lands. Majority of the population in the surrounding areas live in extreme poverty. People face many problems in their day to day lives like nutrition, transportation in village side, poverty, education, disability etc., This place has high number of people suffering from Bone fractures, and severe disability problems. Totally this district has high rate of challenged people and other wise able people.

### What is the Importance of Customized wheelchairs to Disabled People?:

The Association of People with Disability (APD) has started Wheelchair Service Programme in the year 2005 in collaboration with the Motivation, a UK based organization to provide quality wheelchairs for persons with severe & multiple disabilities. These chairs are specially designed/redesigned to meet the health conditions, life style and according to the needs and requirements of the users. The APD provides wheelchairs by assessing the person's health, Prescription, Body measurement, fitting (comfortable movement, seating positions and pressure relief to the user), APD finally provides training on wheelchair and brings awareness about the maintenance to the wheelchair user. Wheelchair is not only used for sitting, but a wheelchair really changes a life of challenged person and brings dignity through Rehabilitation, Education and Employment.

Margaharshi and APD jointly conducted Assessment camp at Aland Tq, Gulberga on 11th of October 2014. In this camp we have identified 49 beneficiaries in surrounding places to be provided with customized wheelchairs. The measurements were taken during the camp.

**the Mission:** When we were all struck in getting the required funds for these wheel chairs, GOD sent messengers from abhaya Foundation, FKCCI & ICSI B'lore Chapter knocked the doors of Margadarshi... these Institutions jointly hosted a national seminar on CSR at Bengaluru. It was a surprise for us to know that they decided to spend the pooled funds by way of sponsorship/ registration for the welfare of most needy people in the State of Karnataka. We were delighted to know that they have found us to translate their thoughts in to ACTIONs. When we approached them seeking support for procuring special wheel chairs, the way CA IS Prasad & CS G Thirupal responded was like seeing GODs in reality. We felt amazed to see them in our journey to serve the needy. The committee at once released Rs.1,25,000/- for Margadarshi and with that fund support the procurement happened. Then our journey to serve the most needy went to the next level.

## Wheel Chairs Distribution Camp on 01.02.2015

From 29th to 31st January'2015 a fitment camp was arranged at Kadakanchi Village. During this camp beneficiaries to whom measurements were taken earlier were called and fitted the wheelchairs according to their body nature and requirements. A team of four technical persons from Association of People with Disability worked very hard and modified the wheelchairs according to their needs and body nature.

On 01.02.2015 a distribution event was arranged at Kadakanchi Village. This event was arranged by Margadarshi in association with APD, Grameena Abhyudaya Seva Samsthe and Abhaya Foundation.

The function was inaugurated by Chief Guests presented on the Dias. After the inauguration our Chief Guest, the Founder of abhaya Foundation CS Balachandra Sunku delivered wonderful speech about the disabilities and challenges being faced by challenged people / NGOs. The speech was very much inspiring, encouraging and applauded by the audience. CS Balachandra Sunku and Sri.Pothanna Setty along with other Guests distributed the wheelchairs to all beneficiaries. Audience and beneficiaries felt happy and were all felt emotional. After the distribution event Mr.Narasimha Murthy and his team from APD provided training to beneficiaries about the usage and maintenance of wheelchairs. We have seen how soon, the life of immobility turned into mobility. ## abhaya FKCCI & ICSI B'lore Chapter provided Rs. 2.5 Lakhs for Mathru Foundation to construct home for disabled:


Paraplegic brave heart, Arjuna awarded and Padmashree Malathi K. Holla, afflicted by polio at infancy, stands tall in the world of paraplegic sports in India by sheer grit and determination and has won medals around the world. This 45 year old Bank Manager has launched the "Mathru Foundation" to serve the physically challenged with motherly care in the year 2005.

Mathru Foundation has started its functions since inception in the quarter (rented house) provided by the HAL Management. Currently Mathru Foundation is serving only for the physically disabled children by providing food, shelter and medical support along with their overall development. All these services are given to them free of cost. The contributions/donations is the only source of income from the public who have recognized and appreciated our work for the last 8 years. They have not yet received any grants or help from the Government for our activities.



In the current accommodation, the organization is able to provide services only to 20 children and the place is not sufficient to provide these services to more and more children. Mathru Foundation is planning to come up with its own building project for which the proprietor of Pragathi Printers Mr. Ravichandra Rao has donated his 3000 sq ft land to the organization. In order to provide services to large number of children's (nearly 100 members) under one roof (ground and two upper floors). Mathru Foundation has started its construction work in this area with an estimated cost of Rs. 2.5 crore. The Foundation proposes to generate funds through generous contributions/donations from Corporate, Trusts and individual donors. Several people have come forward to contribute liberally for the construction of the building. We appeal people to contribute liberally to complete the building work and to help us to fulfill the dream of extending our services to the large number of physically disabled children.

### Inmate Kameswara Rao

Went to Dr. Mukundh Rao today for follow up check. He is to continue on insulin as a therapeutic medicines for foreseeable future, at least 6 months, but with regular reviews to adjust the dosage and to slowly taper, but he is sure he needs it along with other medicines. 24U in morning and 16U in night with Glycomet TBD after meals. He has given some supplements of Vitamin D and vitamin B complex.

But Rao is very cheerful, much fitter. He has almost completely stopped bedwetting and has lot of control now. He cleans his place here, keeps his things properly. He dries his bedsheet and blanket in sun every morning. Take bath in the early morning and wears clean dress. Now I can term him "normal" in that sense. He need not be relegated to the toilet place in AHOH. His hunger and diet has come down a lot and he is aware of what he is eating. I have encouraged him to do the candle coordination, as well as start to think about the hostel, but I am not sure without people around him how good his recovery will be. What we have given him is absolute care as a member of the family here, I am hoping things will be same or better.

From money point of view, it may cost us regularly insulin plus medicines and 4 weekly sugar tests., totaling to about 3K, I will continue to put in that for him. What is most important is someone out there in AHOH to administer his medicines and control his diet. With Kusuma not being there I wish there is someone who can play that role. From next week I will also be on lot of travel, luckily last 3 weeks I was fully at home, and Dad also cooperated a lot. Please do give me a call once you come and let's sit and discuss the way forward for aHoH - **Srikanth Natarajan, Hyderabad**

### Inmate Abida

Myself and Mr. Narayana Murthy @ aHoH took Abida to Global Hospitals on 4th noon, Got her the ENG neurological test done, as well as showed her to the consultant neurologist Dr. Suresh. She has been diagnosed with chronic seizure disorder, often linked to genetic reasons (historical). The medication is must and immediate, so he has put her on tablets - Lamitor, initially small doses to check for allergies, and then increase it. The existing Levipril is to be continue for couple of weeks and then she is off that. He did warn that sometimes there is a drug intolerance and allergy which can be life threatening so has to be monitored closely. The medication itself is very cheap and can be easily affordable for them., I have got them supplies for couple of weeks, and we see Dr. Suresh in two weeks time. Some basic precautions on the case of seizures have been explained to them / Kusuma. Hope she gets well over a period of time, and she is a sweet girl -- her education can be taken care here and she can be an asset over time. - **Srikanth**



I wish to thank abhaya for being so kind to me, your consideration to help me in taking up father's medical treatment was a kindest gesture I have ever felt, as you know dad is not keeping well for the last few years ,he is been on dialysis for the last 3 and half years, initially I got him treated with Yashoda Hospital and from last 4 months he is undergoing treatment at KIMS. I am able to get a discount at KIMS. Apart from dialysis medicines cost is about Rs. 5000/- per month there are hemoglobin injections that have to be administered once a week which would cost me about Rs.1600-2400/- per month. Medical tests cost me 1500/- per month,so each month an expenditure of Rs. 25000/- is certain for dad's treatment.

There is a deficit of 10-15k per month is always there, after a journey of 3 and half years of borrowing money, I have become tired and depressed with my day to day life, myself respect takes a blow after blow, making me feel worthless, I wonder how many lakhs would guarantee me my lost happiness, peaceful happy nights, the money management that I do every day is a complete non sense ,all in all there is only one thing I keep praying to GOD Sai Baba everyday, asking him to safe guard the respect of my parents & family, fearing I might play a spoil sport, because they don't deserve bad experience because of my stupidity. 



I am very much happy and seemed to be surprised to lead and continue such a wonderful, thrilling journey in this Godly profession by the spark of divinity that flashes before me in the form of Abhaya and hope all abhayans are well and good there. During this month I have been posted to surgery. Here we are still in the process of learning how to present a case sheet for different cases like swelling, ulcers, hernia etc. Of the six days in a week, we will spend two days in OP. patients are the real books for us .so we will take upon a case, we will discuss among ourselves to put it in the form of case sheet and then we will present it in front of the doctor .so doctors will teach us how to investigate and how to diagnose etc., Two days we will go to operation theatre .Till now I have come across surgeries like thyroidectomy, phimosis case ,appendectomy through laparoscopy, hygroma, anal fistula case etc.,

In the first year we deal only with the cadavers (dead bodies) but now, live persons. However, it is divine experience to see such beautiful creations of God. Doctors will complete each surgery within 20 to 30 minutes one by one, so much skilfully .Based on the complication of the case, time consumption would be there. But lot of patience and perseverance is required for this field. Whenever I feel vexed with these subjects, these experiences will refuel, activate and brings much more enthusiasm in me. Remaining two days, we will study cases in wards. In between these days only am learning how to dress a wound, etc.

One more awesome experience in this month was that Vijayawada programme. As per the students selected by the professors, myself and my friend saikrupa, we went representing our college at DR.NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES. Medicos, BDS students, nursing students, medical, paramedical students of different colleges gathered there. The main motto of this program is women empowerment. keeping in the mind ,about the vicious attacks over women in the present society, this self defence training program was organised by Dr.kolli sri karuna Murthy (NSS coordinator) .Here we didn't learnt any karate or kung fu ,rather we learned very simple ,smart techniques like hand grab, joint manipulation, anti rape drill, high intensity tactics, weapons of opportunity, biomechanics, multi opponent survival system and some warm ups ,cardio, strength to built physical fitness etc., This program highlighted about body language, self confidence, personality. There is no need to give much importance to the physical strength in order to escape from opponents and defend ourselves, but presence of mind is essential in order to not become a victim. So Deepthi Shankar who got trained in Isryl and approximately trained about 50,000 girls across the country, mainly highlighted that "MIND IS THE STRONGEST WEAPON". This was issued to TV channels, newspapers also .so I have even enclosed photos regarding it. After coming from there a grant program was commenced by the principal and some chief guest. So we started training our classmates, juniors, professors. Every one indulged, involved and learned with very much enthusiasm. Every one developed confidence and they told that, the training program created a platform, where they can Darley face any kind of threatens in the society. We created awareness about different acts like Nirbhaya act, pan India 1091act,sexuall harassment at women working place, etc., thus we successfully accomplished to our level best and brought good name to the college in university through our active participation in every task and even we too got good impression from all professors and thus we were focused. ### Tips to prepare

**Know the syllabus clearly:** Follow your class lessons properly to cover your syllabus in a systematic manner. The class lessons are probably the first introduction of the topics to you. **Solve questions:** Try and solve the questions at the end of each topic and also the last ten years' papers. If you are stuck, make sure you have it resolved by the next day at the maximum. Take help from teachers and seniors, as needed.

**Maintain separate notebooks for each subject:** Jot down important notes and formulae that you come across during your studies. This will help before the exams as you can just grab the subject notebook and revise the portions you want.

**Highlight important points:** Highlight important points and formulae on textbooks and reference books to locate them easily. Revise the points as and when you get time.

**Plan your studies:** Chalk out a time table for board exam preparation and allocate ample time for each subject. Choose the time that you think is best for study. It can be early in the morning or late at night. Do not allow distractions to mar your studies. Select a study space that you feel is most suitable and convenient.

**Know your strengths and weaknesses:** Hone your strengths but do not ignore your weaknesses. Concentrate more to improve on them. Take guidance from your teachers.

**Revise Well:** Do not study anything new or from a new book right before exams, as you may get confused. Revise what you have studied and glance at important notes and formulae. Make note of important formulae and keep them handy so that you can take a look at them as and when you want. Make a weekly revision plan once you have completed the entire syllabus.

**Keep fit:** Eat healthy and take ample rest. Make sure you are also spending some time playing and re-energizing yourself.

As circulated earlier, the meeting of abhaya Volunteers is held at abhaya, Masabtank, on Sunday, 08.02.2015, at 10AM. It is attended by about 15 volunteers, 2 Trustees of abhaya Foundation. The meeting started with abhaya prayer. Then the Founder thanked all

those who are present and stated that this meeting is called to have brain storming of ideas on many aspects with which the Volunteers are associated and to take the Foundation forward. He opined that in order to create a spark, both positive and negative ends need to be connected. He felt happy that the groups from Ibrahimpatnam and Jeedimetla are doing good work by arranging meetings for school students of those two areas. he wanted Volunteers to express their opinions / ideas about abhaya Foundation, what is to be done to make it more effective, whether they need further support to execute etc.

By and large volunteers broadly felt that volunteering is to be stabilized, more group coordination among volunteers needed, require constant guidance, activities should be done more frequently at abhaya Home to propagate the concepts of the Foundation, etc., It is felt that we need to have manpower / admin support at abhaya Home as well as abhaya. Since the exams are fast approaching the schools / students will be occupied and only congregation of students can be arranged for half day / full day at abhaya Home for Ibrahimpatnam / Jeedimetla schools before 15.02.2015. The concept is " How

to prepare for the ensuing exams?" The book " Need of the hour" will be distributed.

Mr.Sivakrishna then stated for the last three months the Foundation has been busy conducting CSR Seminars (done purely with abhay's resources and without anybody's contribution) at Hyderabad, Bengaluru, and Chennai and hence could not devote much time for all the aspects under H.E.A.R.T.

He informed that while the Seminars at Hyderabad and Bengaluru are very successful but the one at Chennai does not fit in to the same, for lack of local support. He reiterated that all through it has been a one man show to organize these Seminars, which resulted in lot of strain. He feels this has to be understood and people should come forward to share the workload willingly. The need of the hour is to equip the Foundation with a dedicated driver / cook/ nurse to carry on with the activities at abhaya Home. The available infrastructure at abhaya Home is under utilized since at least 50 persons can be accommodated there. Pooling of Resources as well as Manpower has to be done urgently and all volunteers need to get focused on this aspect.

He wanted people to contribute at least small amounts of Rs. 100, 200 per month, to help the Foundation stabilize.





The Founder then wanted the Volunteers to confirm their association with the Foundation till the end, come what may. He got a positive response for this from all. He then wanted to know whether abhaya's concepts need to be corrected / redefined. All felt that present system needs no correction and all concepts are fine.



He wanted to know the constraints / priorities / lack of interests of Volunteers. He posed 10 aspects which are to be addressed / supported urgently by Volunteers to enable him to concentrate on other IMPORTANT ITEMS of the Foundation.

# Orientation Session @ Hyderabad (Telangana) for Class X Students



I received a conglomeration of photographs taken at Prakasam School with "... thanks to Pavan " written on them. But in fact, I should thank you sir, for obliging me and conducting such wonderful session. One girl at the end of the session narrated her daily routine. The girl must be about 11 years. Her day starts with getting up before 6.00 a.m and going around doing house hold jobs till 8.00 a.m. Then she has just enough time to get ready and go to school. The sad part is after her school, back home around 4 p.m. she is again going around for two hours till 6.00 p.m doing household jobs. Yes it is inevitable that such deprived families cannot make their children sit at home and the children have to contribute to the family income.

Since yesterday, I was thinking as to how we can help these kind of families. I wish to share my thoughts and seek your valuable suggestions. My idea is when the school is closed for summer vacation, we could conduct a summer camp by a fine arts teacher who would train these deprived students and also colony children. Part of fee paid by colony children could be used to pay part of the training cost of the deprived children. Shortfall could be raised by donations/sponsorship.

After about 30 days training (10 days X 3 skills like Quilling, Diyas painting, Lamasa Clay work etc) the children can make greetings cards, gift envelopes, Quilling ornaments, and designer Diyas, Lamasa Clay products etc which can be sold at outlets, corporate gifts or maybe put in Abhaya website for sale and the proceedings go to the deprived families. Training cost with material per skill is about. Rs.700 so raising about Rs1500 per child for training in 2 skills should not be a problem. In all if we are training 10 girls to start with, we need to raise about Rs15000. I have seen designer Diyas, Lamasa Clay models and Quilling gift envelopes designed by children of about 10 years old and they are sold quite good in numbers during festival season.

Yes all said and done, we need to convince the parents to send their children for the training camp so that they are equipped with better earning skills and over period of time, the children can develop this hobby into a lucrative activity. With valuable suggestions from your side, I hope this idea could give these small girls a better living standard - **K.Pavan, Managing Partner, Lakshmi Venkateshwara Industries, Jeedimetla, Hyderabad.**




