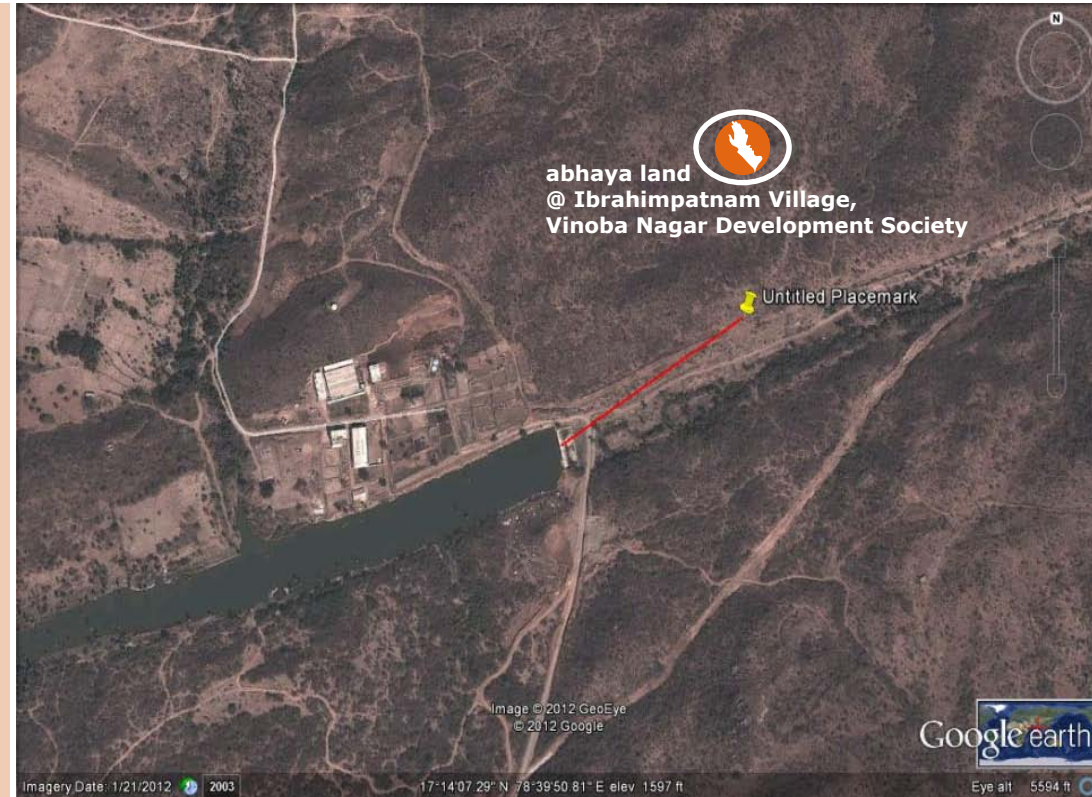

Teachers explained the significance of the Telugu New Year to all the students and distributed "Ugaadi Pacchadi" to all. Almost 200 people being provided lunch on that day.



## abhaya Vignan School Committee met at Hyderabad

Abhaya Vignan School, successfully completed yet another year. Abhaya School Correspondent Smt Padmavathi & Secretary of School Society Sri Vitoba visited Hyderabad and met with abhaya trustees and reviewed the activities that were carried out by them during the last year and deliberated on Year Plan for the year 2012-13. abhaya congratulating all the faculty members for their good efforts to bring change in the remote village. The team felt satisfactory with the over all performance of the school and noted the issues faced in the current year. The total strength of the school was 175 this year and expected slight increase in new admissions this year. The following are the points discussed in the meeting.



- ◆ There is no revision in fee considering poor family back ground of all the students.
- ◆ 10% increase in the salaries of all the staff who are working has been approved.

- ◆ Additional civil works to be carried out to provide more comfort for the school kids.
- ◆ The estimated cost of the said works to submitted to the abhaya Board with in a month.
- ◆ The civil works to be completed before reopening of school.
- ◆ Improve the reporting standard and maintain clarity in the accounts
- ◆ Abhaya Board agreed to provide lease rental of Rs.6000/- for using the entire premises owned by Sri Babulal, the land lord considering there was nothing paid since last couple of years.
- ◆ Selfless work and attitude of gratitude to be the way of life for all the teaching staff so that the values will be understood by the villagers and students.
- ◆ The estimated monthly support needed to the school would be around Rs.20,000/-

An intro meeting for those registered students belong to **VASAVI/CVSR/MVSR/TKR/NARAYANAMMA/GURUNANAK/SRI INDU Colleges** was organized by abhaya at Hyderabad and about 40 enthusiastic engineering students participated in the said meeting. Everyone present expressed their desire to help the needy, joy for giving something to the needy and in the process they try to develop themselves in to good human beings.

Sri. E.J.P.Prasad, who joined abhaya after his retirement from LIC of India, expressed that ever since he joined the "TEAM abhaya", he is seeing life from an entirely different angle and enjoying spending his spare time purposefully and with a sense of satisfaction. He complimented all the young students who are aspiring to become Volunteers for a social cause from a very young age, and wished them god speed in their efforts.

Ms. Shushma, Coordinator of GET sharing her long standing association and experience with abhaya, emphasized the need to work as a TEAM, its advantages, task orientation, distribution of tasks, sharing burden for achieving common goals, contribution of ideas for better results and for giving better services to the concerned. She requested students to concentrate on their studies first and then spare their additional time for social services. She also stated that huge contributions are not expected at their level but as little amounts of Rs. 50/- or Rs. 100/- per month, will go a long way to help a social cause.

Mr.Surya(CVSR) explained as to how he is influenced by the good social service done by Abhaya and how he tried to spread its message to his classmates.

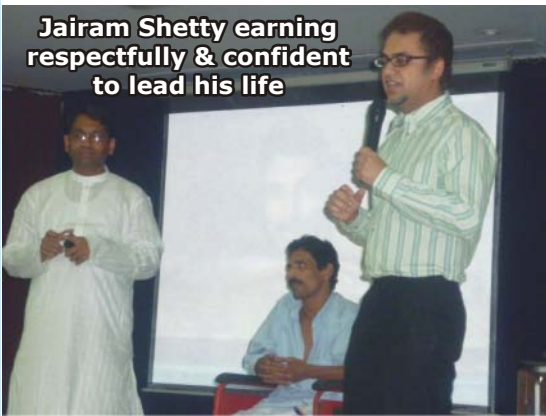

# “HEART” Rural Development Update



## Chandrakala & her children who are otherwise able reprogrammed their life with abhaya

Ever since, my associating with Abhaya Foundation, my perception has changed on many facets of life and am really enjoying doing good work, which I have been longing to do, for many years, in my life.

**1st Week:** This is to share my findings with a family which is in crisis, an aged Mother, Chandrakala (70 years), in a village called Isnapur near Hyderabad), who is fighting hard to support her 3 grown up son and a divorced daughter who is deaf and dumb. leading life less days due to muscular dystrophy, a rare disease which does not have a cure

**2nd Week:** When we visited them at their residence, at the village, to enquire about their situation to extend support, from Abhaya... they felt very happy and one should see and experience their confidence level and their positive outlook on life!!! it is really amazing, to say the least...



**3rd Week:** Abhaya decided to set up a livelihood mechanism by establishing "Abhaya Aathma Viswasa Tiffin Center" in their home by making use of the available space and market around. Accordingly we moved the project. Abhaya provided some resources for them. Accordingly the civil work is completed and the carpenter has started his work. He is confident and by this week end the entire work will be completed. We procured all that is needed for setting up a Tiffin center.

**4th Week:** Abhaya reprogrammed yet another needy family. ABHAYA has taken up the case of Mrs.Chandrakala and her THREE HANDICAPPED SONS in right earnest, and tried to give them the required support. As a result of this, on Sunday, 22.04.2012, as per the date and time fixed by their family members, the ABHAYA TEAM visited the home of Mrs.Chandrakala at ISNAPUR village ,Medak District of A.P and enabled the family to open "ABHAYA ATMA VISWASAM TIFFIN CENTRE" It is a testimony for our FOUNDATION'S eagerness to help the people in need and to extend support, as early as possible and make it happen at the fastest possible time frame !!

Abhaya Team handed over all the items necessary, purchased specially to run the Tiffin centre to the family. Sri.Rajender of S.K.HOME NEEDS, Hyderabad, has also given 12 steel Tiffin plates for this purpose and abhaya salutes him for his Godly assistance. The family was guided by abhaya to complete civil and carpentry work which was necessary to run the Tiffin centre. All the items to be sold on a day to day basis at the centre are neatly arranged in the racks and slowly the family's well wishers, neighbors etc started coming.

The abhaya team witnessed the most memorable event when the family opened the Tiffin Center on 22.04.2012 which gave them BOOST. All the villagers promised to be regular customers and also tell their friends to visit the center to help the family. The family is advised to monitor things properly on a day to day basis and maintain income and expenditures and deposit amounts regularly in the bank.

# Venkatesh to Reprogram his Life

Venkatesh, who lost both his hands and leg in an accident due to electrical shock. His case was telecasted on 08.04.2012 in VANITHA TV - "BATUKU BANDI" program and someone provided abhaya's reference... no one else responded. Abhaya lovingly called them to understand the situation.

His two brothers sustaining with the help of autos in Sherlingampalli near Hyderabad. They contribute around Rs 4000/- pm to the family. Venkatesh gets Rs. 500/- as disability pension from the Government and old parents are not in a position to take care of him.

Considering his hopeless condition abhaya agreed to provide one DIESEL AUTO and the family can run by giving it for rent and the daily return on the same will be around Rs.250/- to Rs. 300/- when it becomes substantial, the same can be used to provide artificial limbs to Venkatesh in future. Both the brothers agreed



to contribute Rs.25000/- from their end for purchase of an auto.

Knowing about abhaya's help VANITHA TV crew made yet another appeal seeking help for venkatesh, informing abhaya's intention of contributing lion's share financially for this purpose. Appeals made by TEAM ABHAYA, Venkatesh and his elder brother Shivakumar were also filmed by the TV crew on 22.04.2012 in VANITHA TVs "Batuku Bandi" program, in which, an appeal was again made to extend help to him, financially. It was once again emphasized the promise made by ABHAYA to contribute substantially for his cause.

We are VERY HAPPY to inform you all that, in response to this appeal through Vanith TV on 22.04.2012, an amount of Rs.7500/- is received, so far, by Venkatesh, from the public. A beginning has been made for this GODLY WORK and let us hope for the best at the earliest, so that, VENKATESH'S LIFE CAN MOVE FORWARD and he may lead a NORMAL LIFE AFTER SOME TIME in future.

# SIRISHA MEMORIAL CHARITABLE TRUST

## You can refer Orphan Boys for building their lives



Padmasri Dr AVS Raju along with his family members established Sirisha Memorial Charitable Trust in the year 2001 with aim to provide love and care to the orphan children and to make them good citizens of the society. The trust is situated with in a distance of 7.00 Kms from Patancheru, Medak Dist.Andhra Pradesh.

Facilities like spacious rooms, food arrangement, dairy cattle and school facility upto 7 th std are available. Once the inmates complete their 7th std they will be sent to English Medium School at Patancheru in their Bus and further take care of them for higher education.

The trust is having 14 acres of land in which two big buildings with an area of 20,000 sq feet are constructed. The requirement for children like rice, wheat, fruits like banana, mango, coconut, cashew etc are grown in the campus. Facilities like drinking water (Manjeera), generator, solar heater and a computer lab in the campus.

The campus can accommodate 50 children and At present the trust propose to take about 20 kids during this year.

### ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMITTING THE BOYS

- ◆ Boy, either an orphan or with a single living parent.
- ◆ Age can be between 6- 14 years. Can be relaxed in deserving cases.
- ◆ The boy should not have any chronic disease.
- ◆ It is open to any caste, religion and region.
- ◆ The boy should be preferably a Telugu speaking and school going
- ◆ Admitting the boys will be the sole discretion of the management.

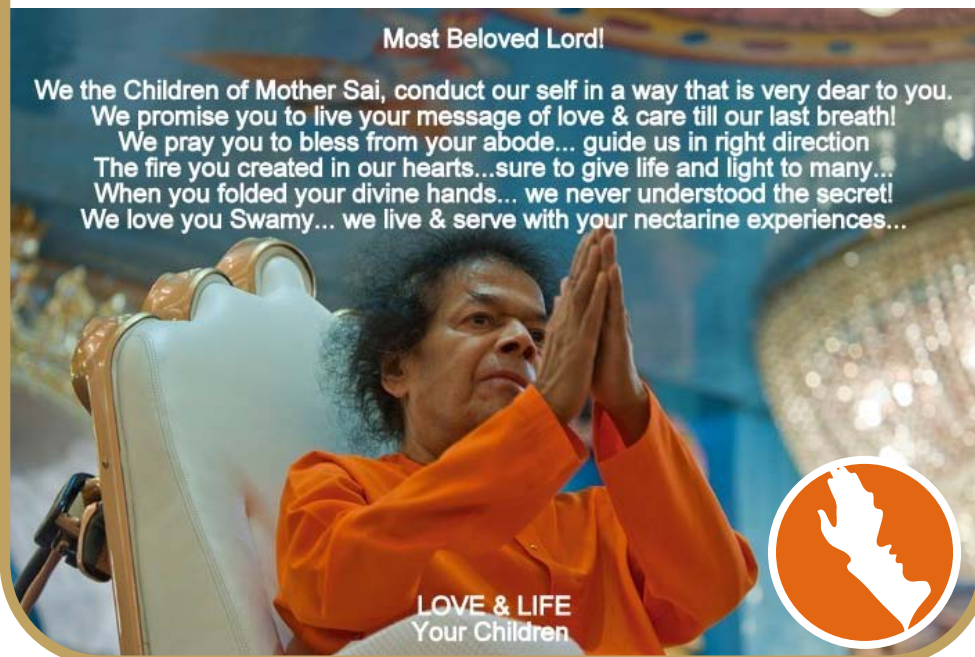

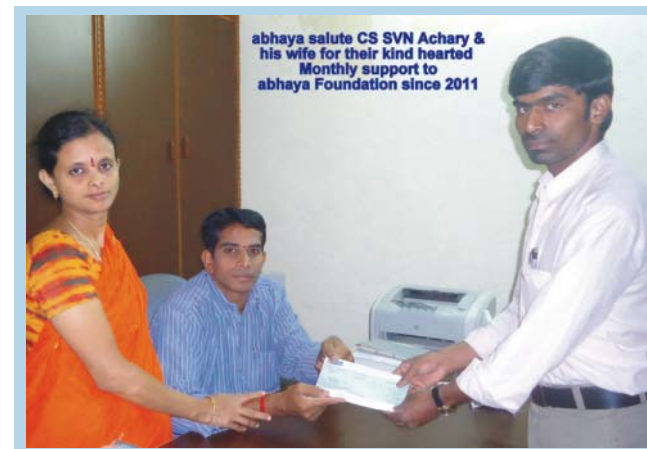
