CSR Update



Jayapura rides crest of development boom



Journalists are visiting Jayapura in droves to study "development" — Mr. Modi's model of development — which the village epitomises. Villagers admit that the flurry of developmental activities in the last seven months has

been unprecedented. Most homes in the village have got new toilets, and houses for the poor have been constructed, undertaken mostly by Corporate Social Responsibility wings of major companies.

Jayapura was little heard of until the Prime Minister adopted it. But the lucky village has now received a visible boost in rural banking, road construction and solar power projects. At the house of the village head Durgavati Devi, solar power panels imported from China could be seen lined up for installation works.

Sonu Patel, a resident, proudly showed off a solar-powered lantern. Such lanterns were distributed to villagers here recently. The streets too got new solar-powered lights, sponsored by the Union Bank of India's CSR wing. Om Prakash, an employee at the local Syndicate Bank branch, said the bank had opened 300 accounts for villagers under the Jan Dhan Yojana. Easy loans were being processed for farmers and small business owners to boost the local economy.



Bosch CSR activities

The thrust areas of Bosch Limited CSR include child-health, -hygiene and -education, vocational training focused on employability skills, and neighborhood projects as per the local needs identified by company's plants and offices.

Bosch Limited's Child Health Development Program has scaled up since its start in 2010, on addressing around 26,000 students from 125 Government schools. Another notable initiative of the Company is a two months long employable skill program. The program is being organized in more than 50 centers in the country including 25 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in Karnataka and so far led to employment of over 1500 youth. Over the past few years, the Company has set-up six reverse osmosis plants to provide clean drinking water; the model has currently become self-sustained, supporting over 2,400 families.

The railways is eyeing the huge corporate social responsibility funds available with the government's public sector units (PSUs) to upgrade and modernize passenger amenities at platforms. To begin with, the state-run transporter will sign MoUs with railway PSUs for taking up works to ensure better facilities for travelers using their CSR funds at 10 stations during the ongoing 15-days customer facilitation drive that started on May 26.

The Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) and the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA) have come together to create an online platform called Sammaan (www.bsesammaan.com) to help corporates comply with the rules and regulations laid down in the recently amended CSR Law.

This platform has been created to identify and pick the right NGOs capable enough to work with corporates listed under the CSR category. The move is an attempt to bring greater efficiency and transparency to CSR practices. Since India is home to about more than 2 million NGOs, it is imperative that we devised a system of accreditation to build a sense of assurance and trust among the corporates. Sammaan will bring together BSE's exchange capabilities along with the strong industry connect of CII and the knowledge expertise of IICA," Nikhil Pant, chief programme executive - CSR, disclosed at the CSR Convergence Meet organized by CII Eastern Region in Kolkata on Friday. Incidentally, IICA is a central government organization and has played a crucial role in formulating the CSR rules and guidelines.

Volkswagen breaks ground at drought affected village

Maharashtra is already known for its farm crisis and reports the highest number of farmer's suicides in the country. The drought brought in by a delayed and inadequate monsoon further deepens the distress for its cultivators. In a move to aid the drought-affected village Naiphad of Maharashtra, Volkswagen India has stepped in by sponsoring Rs 51 lakh to construct water bunds.



The company initiated the CSR project at this drought-affected village located in the Khed district by conducting the ground breaking ceremony. Naiphad, located close to Bhimashankar, is the second village at which Volkswagen India has undertaken a project to overcome water scarcity. With this, Volkswagen states that it continues its global tradition of supporting social projects in the region around its production facilities.

Toilets in Schools: SBI Hyderabad donates Rs 2.19 Crore

As part of its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative, the State Bank of India's (SBI) Hyderabad circle donated `2.19 crore for construction of 102 toilets in 53 government schools in Adilabad district under the Swachh Vidyalaya campaign.

Deputy managing director of the SBI's Hyderabad Circle, CR Sasikumar said SBI will help in providing water by laying bores and pipelines. The toilets will be maintained by the bank for two years through the Wockhardt Foundation. He said `12 lakh was donated to AIM for SEVA, a voluntary organization, for provision of food, uniforms, and other supplies to 50 students of a Students' Home in Adilabad district.

Maharashtra government tapping corporates for funding anti-drought project

To fund its ambitious Jalyukta Shivar drought alleviation project, the Maharashtra government is tapping the corporate sector for help. This project, which aims at tackling recurring drought in rain-fed areas and ensuring water and moisture security, has covered around 6,000 villages where 30,000 works are underway.

An official from the chief minister's office (CMO) said that they had recently held a conclave with representatives of corporate groups to seek deployment of corporate social responsibility (CSR) funds, technical inputs and know-how for the program. "These companies have already covered around 400 villages, of which some are part of the Jalyukta Shivar program and others are not," said the official, adding that these works were estimated at Rs200 crore.



ICAI issues norms for CSR accounting by Companies

The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) recently issued a guidance note which will help India Inc in accounting for its corporate social responsibility (CSR) expenses.

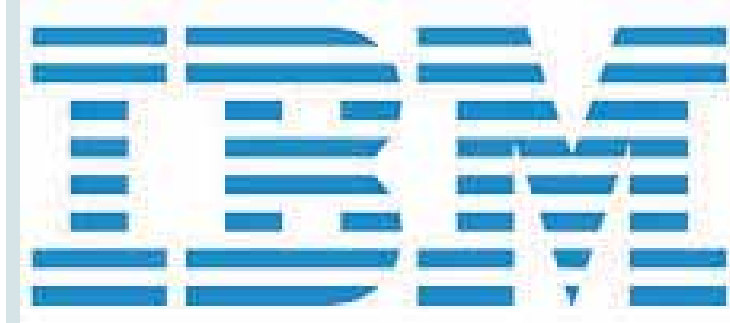
To ensure transparent financial reporting, this guidance note requires the company to debit (charge) its profit and loss account (P&L a/c) with the CSR expenses incurred by it during the year. Further, such expenses are to be shown as a separate line item in the P&L a/c.

The guidance note by calling for a debit to the P&L a/c of the CSR expenditure rightly puts to rest an ongoing debate as to whether such expenditure could have been adjusted as an appropriation from reserves," says Sumit Seth, partner, PriceWaterhouse.

Further, ICAI's guidance note has also addressed issues of a shortfall by a company in meeting with the minimum CSR expenditure criteria and also those instances where a company has spent more than the minimum requirement.



IT giant to chalk out disaster management plan



Post cyclone Hudhud, the State government has been consulting various agencies to devise a foolproof plan to mitigate and manage nature's fury in future. In such a move, the district administration has invited global IT giant IBM to study, research and analyse and work out an effective disaster management plan. A three-member team from IBM, Bengaluru, headed by Mamtha Sharma, Head of Corporate Citizenship and Corporate Affairs, was here on Wednesday to discuss with stakeholders and key personnel from various departments such as horticulture, fire services, agriculture and communication, to understand the issues, critical aspects and problems.

Speaking to The Hindu, Ms. Sharma said that Visakhapatnam was among the three cities in India selected by IBM for working in coordination with the district administration to devise a plan to address at least one key issue. "In the case of Visakhapatnam, we thought that a strong disaster management plan will be the priority, as the city is prone to cyclones. In Surat we are working on integrated civic services and in Allahabad we are doing a project on water management," she said.

Nellore schools to get self-cleaning e-toilets



With a plan to set up 362 e-toilets in schools in Nellore district, it will become the first district to have the highest number of e-toilets in schools in India.

The automated, self-cleaning and unmanned e-toilets are being set up in the schools as a part of the CSR initiative of Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) in the Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan, Anwar Sadat, CEO of Eram Scientific, told The Hindu .

The 362 e-toilets will be installed in 316 schools in Nellore district, making it the highest in the country. Until now, Kochi with 105 e-toilets in 30 schools holds the record.

Eram Scientific had announced the world's most economically priced e-toilet on October 2, 2014, Mr. Sadat said. The model called e-Lite14 e-toilet for schools also has automatic floor wash system, automatic ceiling light, exhaust fan, in-built sensors to conserve electricity and water and an overhead water tank, he says explaining the features. The deployment of the toilets, each costing Rs.1 lakh, will be completed by July. Eram Scientific has deployed more than 650 e-toilets in 15 states in India According to Mr. Sadat, it is closely working with the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, California Institute of Technology, Duke University, and University of South Florida etc. for developing next generation sanitation solutions.

Mindteck Shows Support Of Samarthanam Trust For The Disabled



Mindteck, a global technology company listed on the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE 517344), has provided targeted funding to enhance the state-of-the-art computer lab run by Samarthanam Trust for the Disabled. The lab is part of the newly-constructed block of

Samarthanam Trust recently inaugurated in the presence of the Union Minister for Social Justice & Empowerment, Thawar Chand Gehlot, and Union Chemicals and Fertilizer Minister, Ananth Kumar, who praised the efforts of the Trust in empowering 'differently-abled' citizens in the state.

Rajasthan Royals pledges 2% annual profit towards girl child welfare

Rajasthan Royals embarked on an innings of a different kind. The franchise will support the development and welfare of the girl child and has pledged two per cent of the annual profits of the company for the current financial year towards the cause.



Taking inspiration from the Indian Government's 'Beti Bachao Beti Padhao' initiative, the franchise wishes to heighten awareness around the issues facing the girl child, engage with its fans and other cricket lovers, utilize its digital assets to reach out to audiences and seek to make a difference by contributing brand support and monetary resources towards this cause.

Mindteck's funding of "Dialer Software", which will be used via JAWS (Job Access with Speech) software, will help blind and visually impaired users to read screens either by text-to-speech output or by a refreshable braille display. It will enable Samarthanam Trust for the Disabled to employ over 40 visually challenged individuals. -

It was very inspiring journey spending quality time with very gifted talent & pure hearts. The trip covers various Vanavasi Kalyan Hostels situated at heart of western ghats in deep woods. These hostels are established and maintained by Vanavasi Kalyana Kendras, Bangalore, Karnataka having its head quarters at Jashpur Nagar (Chhattisgarh) with an intention to impart education, Samskara and bring all round development in the young tribal kids residing in the forest. We (Sreepadha, CS Ramesh Kumar Bhat

and me) visited the following hostels "Rathnakara" at Kumta" Srirama Vanavasi, Chippagere, Vittala, Ambikar Nagar & Rukmini Girl Hostel, Dandele.

During the interaction with the students it is observed that that these students are taken care with love and passion by the hostel wardens from their personal chores and the students take care of clean and green in and around the hostel. The food is found very nutritious. The students look healthy and very active in indoor and outdoor games apart from their students and prayers. All the students are studying at Govt. schools/ colleges and scoring very good marks.

On the way to other hostels, we happened to visit one of students home in the deep forest around 35 kilometers away from nearby town. It is witnessed the families residing over there in that area facing sever drinking water-shortage especially in the summer season. Though there is good and regular rain fall in the terrain, this particular area, there is no system of water harvesting and storing facilities available. There was demand raised before nearby local government regulatory body around 4 years back. However there is no sign of attending the official them. Being it very basic need... abhaya Foundation wish to construct a well (with a structure of cement circler-ring) for creation of water source. The total cost of well would be around Rs.75,000. Some of well who are natives of nearby areas showing interest to contribute this noble cause. - **CS G Thirupal, Trustee, abhaya, B'lore**

The 24 students of 9th standard are staying back at Sevalayam for the vacations as they are being promoted to 10th standard in the coming academic year. They are taking English Grammar classes and Mathematics classes as well from an Engineering student.



The renovation work has started on 7th of May at Sevalayam and will be finished shortly. The estimated cost for renovation, white wash and painting sums up to Rs.3.23 lakhs(Rs.2.25Lakhs for Civil Work and 98K for white washing and painting all the buildings in Sevalayam).



The Volunteers from Seva team has collected Rs.1,38,500 and Sify Technologies supported through abhaya CSR Seminar at Chennai to the tune of Rs. 1,00,000/- to Harijana Sevak Sangh, India thereby totaling the fund mobilized to Rs 2,38,500 so far. abhaya granted Rs.70,000/- for the civil work and with this fund will come to Rs 3,07,750 and short of Rs 15,250 . 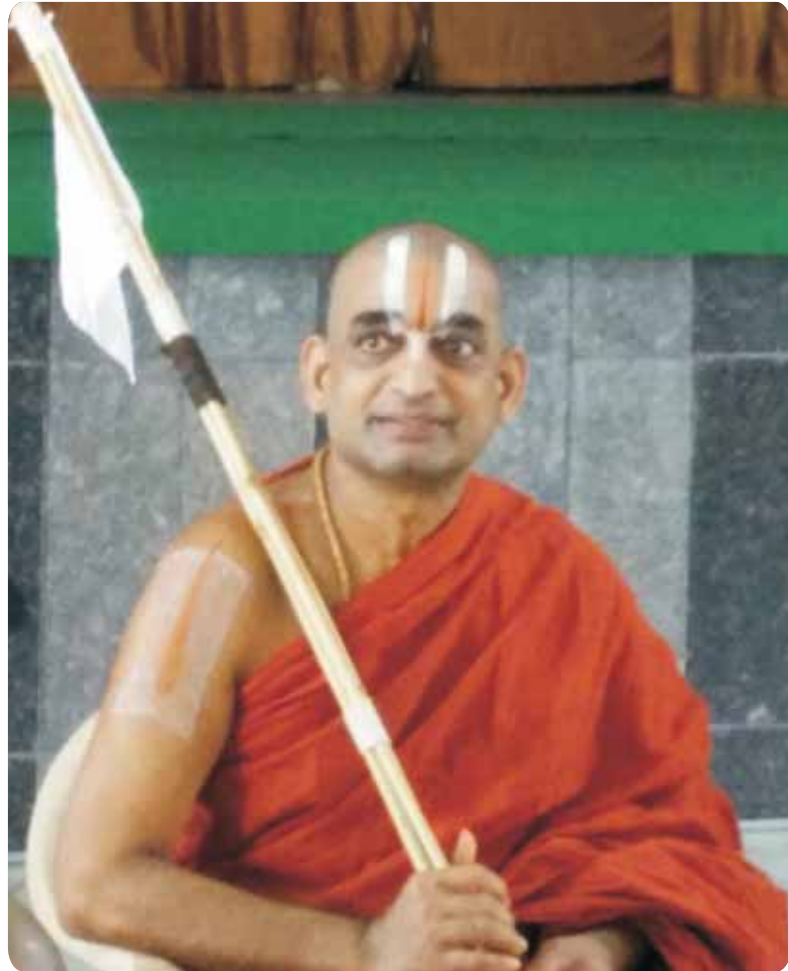

Kusuma... ready to go to abhaya home after 5 months at Rajyalakshmi Hospital post surgery... She needs our Prayers and love

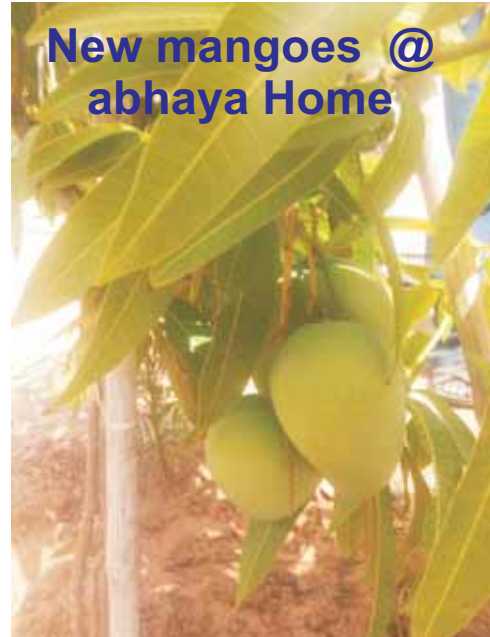

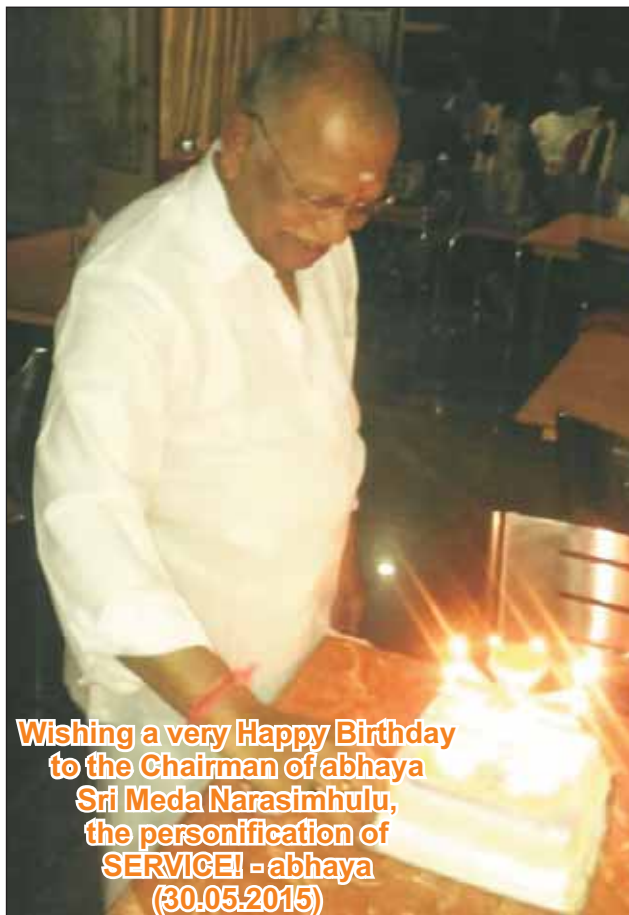

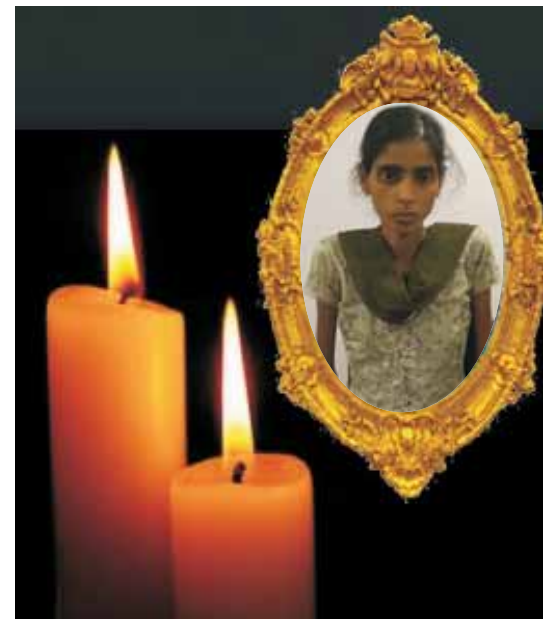


Mission Hari Prasad

I am staying at a private hostel nearby and preparing well for the examinations. My mother is not in a position to pay my hostel fee. I request you to provide some help to complete my Education.

Learning at Thy Feet of Sri Chinnajeeyar

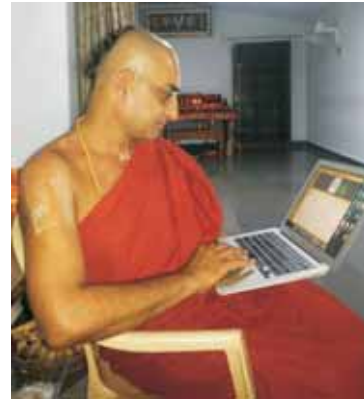

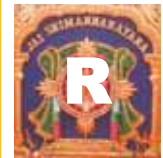
Smile: The most admiring part of HIS Personality is the ever smiling FACE. That genuine smile makes the people around him comfortable in his presence.

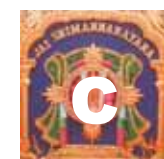

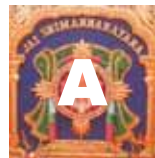

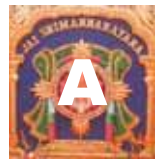
