### CSR rules amended to widen canvas for India Inc

The Centre has broad-based the entities available for carrying out corporate social responsibility (CSR) activities. India Inc can now get CSR implemented through "a company established under section 8 of the Act or a registered trust or a registered society, established by the central government or state government or any entity established under an Act of Parliament or a State legislature,"

This could be done without having to worry about existence of three year track record in undertaking similar projects or programmes.

"We have widened the canvas for corporates. They need not bother about floating their own foundations or trusts or society for undertaking CSR. They can now use the vehicles set up by the Central, State governments or entities set up by an Act of Parliament or State legislatures to carry out CSR," a senior corporate affairs ministry (MCA) official said.

There are many States, which have floated charitable foundations pursuing objects enshrined in the CSR legal framework, and these vehicles could now be utilised by companies for CSR implementation.



The latest rule change may also be helpful for corporate houses to reach out to remote areas where government floated society or trust or foundations are already working.

### CSR activities by tobacco industry invalid: TNPFTC

A major breakthrough has been achieved in the ironical situation of Tobacco Industries involved in Corporate Social Responsibility. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) has given a clarification about Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). The circular dated 16 May 2016 says that the New Companies Act 2013 must not contravene any other prevailing laws of the land including Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA) 2003.

This means that CSR activities by tobacco industry is invalid since Section 5 of Cigarette and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA) prohibits "sponsorship of any trade mark or brand name of cigarettes or any other tobacco products".

WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (FCTC) Article 5.3 states that corporate social responsibility schemes by tobacco industry are really just marketing by another name. When the New Companies Act, 2013 came into force, it contradicted WHO FCTC Article 5.3 and Section 5 of COTPA and moreover legalized CSR activities of Tobacco Industries.

Tamil Nadu People's Forum for Tobacco Control (TNPFTC) had filed PIL in Chennai High Court asking the MCA to Exclude Tobacco Industry from Participating in CSR activities.

According to a release, the members of TNPFTC has welcomed the move of MCA which protects the public from the marketing strategies of Tobacco Industries. With the clarification issued, the CSR activities of Tobacco Industry become invalid and prohibited.



## Proactive rather than reactive CSR efforts needed:

Etihaad Airways announced that it will forego the traditional water cannon salute for the maiden flight of its Airbus A380 to Mumbai on 1 May. Provided by airports to mark the arrival of a first flight, Etihaad took the decision to do away with it because of the drought in Maharashtra.

Taxi aggregator Uber declared a weeklong (2 to 7 May) initiative to collect funds for drought relief. About Rs.2.75 lakh was collected and passed on to not-for-profit World Vision India, which will provide dry rations and water to more than 100 affected households in Maharashtra.

These are just two among many such corporate initiatives in Maharashtra but, in effect, they are little more than band-aid solutions.

“There is increased interest by firms and individuals who want to help, but it is not the surge I would have expected given the scale and intensity of the drought distress,” says Zarina Screwvala, founder and managing trustee of the Swades Foundation, a not-for-profit working in the state.

According to her, the overall problem is so large that it's not just water conservation that needs to be addressed when fighting drought. “Each region has its own unique geographical, topographical, social and political aspects. To tackle the drought, one needs to have a 360-degree approach,” she adds.

Echoing the view, Amrit Pandurangi, partner and leader of infrastructure and capital projects at Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu India Llp, points out, “One of the key concerns is that we are still in a 'reactive' mode rather than taking proactive action towards water sustainability. People conserve water only if there is an acute scarcity, usually in the summers, and then it's business as usual.”

As per an analysis by NextGen, a CSR consultancy firm, based on the annual reports of these companies, they together spent Rs.2,571.10 crore on CSR in FY15, just short of the prescribed amount of Rs.2,888.73 crore.

But, despite 52% of Maharashtra being drought-prone, only a minuscule part of the CSR funds was spent on water conservation, with NextGen pegging the figure at about Rs.1.44 crore. This number was arrived at by taking into account only that expenditure that firms specified as being for the state and for water-related initiatives.

The Maharashtra government's Jalyukt Shivar Abhiyan, an integrated programme to address the deeper causes of drought in the state and find long-term solutions launched in 2014, has also received lukewarm response from corporates.

The scheme was intended to make 5,000 villages water secure every year and make the state drought-free by 2019.

“Companies are working independently and a majority of the funds are being given to the chief minister's relief fund, from where they get distributed to various government drought relief efforts,” says Vinod Wakhare, deputy secretary, water conservation department, and head of the Jalyukta Shivar Abhiyan, by way of an explanation for why the scheme has found few takers.

With increasing water scarcity, it is necessary that companies, not-for-profits and government agencies look at drought proofing and not mere relief work.

“Governments/water departments should draw up and implement plans for effective water utilization, involving the private sector and taking innovations on board. These efforts should go on year round and not only during the crisis months.”



## CSR expenses need to be treated as non-cost items:



ICAI Companies need to treat expenses related to CSR activities as non-cost items and separately disclose transactions in this regard where related parties are involved, according to cost accountants' apex body ICAI.

In a detailed exposure draft of guidance note on 'Treatment of Costs Relating to CSR Activities', the grouping has said that cost auditors should ensure that corporate social responsibility expenses are treated properly and not wrongfully claimed as product or service costs.

According to the Institute of Cost Accountants of India (ICAI), all expenses relating to CSR activities "whether incurred up to the statutory limit of two per cent or more, shall be treated as non-cost items and reflected separately in the profit reconciliation statement". Similarly, all incomes generated out of assets created under CSR projects, programmes and activities, whether recognised as revenue in the profit and loss statement or not, should be treated as non-cost items and shown separately. "The cost auditor has to be extra careful in such situations and check such expenses (or incomes) to ensure their proper treatment in the cost statements. The cost auditor should also bring such deviations to the notice of the Audit Committee or Board, as the case may be," the draft said. On whether excess amount spent on CSR activities under the law can be considered as cost, ICAI has said, "the entire amount is to be shown as non-cost item in the cost statements".

## Parliamentary panel wants PSUs to focus on remote backward areas:

A Parliamentary panel suggested that the central public sector enterprises (CPSEs) should spend money under the CSR obligations on development of the remote backward areas of the country.

The committee is also of the view that as provided by the Companies Act 2013, it is an obligation of a company to be concerned with the well-being of its local populace and environment, the resources of which are being directly utilised by them. "the committee also holds the view that CPSEs should take into account the development of remote backward areas of the country," the panel, in its report presented in Parliament today, said.


These are areas where the pace of industrial development has been slow due to their geographic location, it added.

The committee suggested that the Department of Public Enterprises (DPE) should issue guidelines as to how can the CPSEs extend their CSR oversight to entire supply chain network to ensure that vendors comply with principles of CSR as per DPE guidelines.

"DPE should also allow CPSEs to join in the central and state governments schemes like Mid-day meals, Sarva Siksha Abhiyan as per Schedule VII," it recommended. For this, the DPE should evolve a model arrangements framework between CPSEs and the nodal government agency, which should ensure timely release of utilisation certificates to the CPSEs so that it can reflect the CSR expenditure in its annual accounts, the panel suggested.



## Why monitoring CSR spends is key to social reform



The Finance minister Arun Jaitley in his statement in Rajya Sabha said that during 2014-15, about Rs.6,337 crores was spent on CSR activities. This number would only increase in the coming times with more companies beginning to report their CSR expenditure. CSR is no more just a buzzword, it is slowly becoming a full-fledged strategy that governs, or should govern, a company's interactions with all of its stakeholder-regulators, potential customers and staff, community, suppliers, and the civil society.

With such large expenditures being made towards CSR, it becomes imperative that the projects are monitored and the outcomes are evaluated to ascertain whether the objective with which it was made mandatory, is achieved. "How do we make sure that the money we are spending on CSR is being well spent and that people for whom it is intended are benefitting from it" is a sentiment echoed by many companies. There is likelihood of greater accountability that Companies will bring into the implementation of activities related to social development.

Rising awareness about the CSR legislation has led to stakeholders raising queries about the way the companies are spending this money and the compliance levels. There have been concerns about the monitoring and evaluation mechanism of such huge expenditures. A high level committee setup by the Government under the chairmanship of Shri Anil Bajjal, former secretary to Government of India, to suggest measures for improved monitoring of CSR activities has recommended against the involvement of Government in monitoring and the onus lies solely on the CSR committee of the companies. This puts additional responsibility on the CSR Committee and the Board members to make sure good programmes are designed and managed well.

A pre-requisite for an effective monitoring mechanism is a well thought out CSR strategy and implementation plan defining the inputs and expected outputs and outcomes of the intended activities. A comprehensive plan for social development would not only yield the desired results from the CSR activities it would also lead to ease of operation for the corporates who till now have been engaged primarily in business related activities.

A stringent monitoring mechanism not only helps to gauge and review the progress, it also helps to identify gaps, if. Evaluating the projects can help assess whether the desired outcome and impact has been achieved and the benefit is indeed reaching the intended beneficiaries. With a robust monitoring mechanism in place, the companies would be better equipped to plan their programmes and also engage with multiple stakeholders who have interest in their CSR activities. Needless to say monitoring should be done to assess the progress made on the programme side as well as on the financial utilisations.

## Government seeks CSR spending information under companies law

Finding discrepancies in CSR spending data, the government has asked all eligible companies to furnish details about social welfare activities undertaken by them under the companies law .

While the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) regulations came into force from April 1, 2014, a clear picture of how much money has actually been spent during the first year of implementation 2014-15 is yet to emerge.

Sources said the Corporate Affairs Ministry has asked companies to submit details about utilisation of CSR funds after noticing discrepancies in the data submitted by many of them in their statutory filings.

In this regard, the Registrar of Companies (RoC) has sought information on CSR works from the firms.

A random analysis of filings has indicated discrepancies in submissions about CSR activities. In some instances, firms have submitted that they do not come under CSR regulations while financial data suggest that they indeed come under it, sources said.

The information have been called for by the RoCs to have a clearer picture about compliance with CSR norms, they added.



## Mphasis backs mobile-based SkillTrain through CSR Money



Mobile based skills training platform SkillTrain has raised an undisclosed amount of funding from the corporate social responsibility programme of IT services company Mphasis.

Incubated by social enterprise platform Villgro, SkillTrain will use the money to set up a skill training centre in Indore.

"We currently have five blended learning centres including three centres with NGO partners. We are planning to scale in additional five cities over the next quarter before we look for equity investment," said B Ganesh, founder of SkillTrain.

The vocational training platform provides two-month long video-based and practical training programmes through its blended learning centres and has 21,000 subscribers for its learning channel online across the world.

## Govt to rollout digital literacy program for 6cr people

The Department of Electronics and IT (DeitY) has plans to start e-literacy initiative soon to train 6 crore Indians over a period of next three years as a part of Budget 2016-17 provisions.

"We are starting digital literacy program in this fiscal to train another 6 crore individuals," DeitY additional secretary Ajay Kumar told ET, adding that the initiative under the National Digital Literacy Mission (NDLM) has received an overwhelming response by training 59 lakh individuals within 2 years of inception.

The government in 2014 had set up a preliminary target of providing digital literacy to 52.5 lakh people in four years, which has already been achieved by the department and have undertaken a registration of more than 84 lakh people currently.

The Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (Disha) or National Digital Literacy Mission (NDLM) is a pan-India digital literacy scheme to provide education for free to BPL (below poverty line) households and members of the scheduled caste (SC) and scheduled tribe (ST) communities.

The government has partnered with the Nasscom Foundation which is driving the digital literacy initiative with CSR (corporate social responsibility) funds from the multinationals such as Google, Microsoft, and Intel.



Many private-sector companies, according to the official, have shown interest in the recent past to partner for the e-literacy initiative which Kumar believes, is a critical aspect for the mega Digital India umbrella program.

"The scheme is aimed to facilitate people to become digitally literate so that they can be empowered for digital inclusion."


To make a person IT literate, NDLM is offering a 40-hour course that includes hands-on training on operating digital devices such as mobile devices, tablets and desktop with Internet browsing and search for basic information, online chat and e-mail communication.

The government is also working with content providers to include local languages to make program citizen friendly and is giving special focus to mobility devices in line with government's strategic shift to m-Governance for various citizen-centric services.

He visited the school and interacted with students. The Driving School, Classrooms, Signage, Cut models needed for registration been in place in front of our eyes... which is again a miracle to see and understand. Bharath, the Mountaineer and volunteer did a lot of hard work in setting up the cut models along with the support of Goutham & Mahipal Reddy.



Further, Mahipal Reddy & Sivakumar regularly taking care of the driving classes, repairs, set up, practical, learning licenses and driving licenses.

Whenever Founder visits abhaya Home and whatever may be the time, he always finds time to sit with all the inmates and students. He instantaneously creates a session wherever he sit and involve everyone with his communication skills and motivates them with life skills, this is something very useful for each one who are staying at home.

## abhaya CCL Women Empowerment Centers (Chededu, Ibrahimpatnam & Dadupally)

25 women trained in tailoring for 2 months and provided tailoring machines by bearing 25% cost to 20 women at chededu. CS Sridevi, Company Secretary, CCL Products India Ltd., Hyderabad along with Sathyavathi were kind enough to inaugurate yet another tailoring center at Govt High School, Ibrahimpatnam encouraging most needy women to stand on their feet to overcome poverty and unemployment issues in their life. 



# Corporate Support needed for Gandhi Hospital - Critical Care Unit



which is compromising care levels and outcomes.

The nursing staff levels currently stand at about 1 nurse per 10 beds ICU beds. The ideal ration for an ICU may be 1:1, but we could atleast expect it to be 1:3 or 1:4. We are trying to bridge this gap, by mobilising support for additional nursing and paramedical staff. This is expected to demonstrate improved outcomes in a year or two and make a case for the Government to bridge this gap. During May-2016, UC through its partner NPO Ekam Foundation has recruited and trained 17 nurses who will serve at the Acute Medical Care/Medical ICU of Gandhi Hospital from the first week of June-2016.



I am sharing a brief note which introduces and seeks support for our initiative regarding improving Critical Care Nursing at Gandhi Hospital:

UC has been extending various volunteer services at Gandhi Hospital, Secunderabad over the past 5 years. Since mid-2015, UC, its volunteers and partner NPOs Seva Bharathi and Ekam Foundation, have actively engaged with the Emergency Department at Gandhi Hospital, which receives anywhere from 200 to 300 cases per day, the largest perhaps in Hyderabad. About 60% to 70% of admission to the Hospital happen through the Emergency Department. This area obviously has a huge impact on lives and livelihoods(given the high cost of emergency and critical care in the private sector). While there are enough number of doctors, fortunately, this being a teaching hospital, a big gap seen here is the inadequate nursing and paramedical staff in critical care units,

All the students supported by abhaya should attend this meeting, as this will be planned during Saturday or Sunday or any other public holiday. Its been 6 months since we had such meeting. So we decided to call all the educare team to the dedication event at abhaya Home of Happiness. We called all new and old student members and very disappointed to note the turn out. There are only 6 students, who attended the event. Leelavathi, Swapna Priya, Sai Latha, Sirisha, Abdulla and Nagaraju attended the meeting.

We asked them to introduce themselves and share their progress and needs. One common thing we observed from them is that all of them lack in minimum communication skills. Though we corrected repeatedly, they could not even complete a sentence with confidence. 

Is there a man whose heart will shed tears of blood at the misery of even the meanest of God's creation? It is in his heart--be sure--that the Lord dwells.


