Education - Lighting the Darkened Paths



abhaya believes education is the foundation of social justice. Its initiatives span over 350 Government schools in south Indian states where infrastructure has been upgraded, teachers mentored and students supported with resources.

Through 'abhaya Samskara Kendras' (ask), after-school coaching centers in rural India, over 1,500 students receive daily mentoring, values-based education, and emotional support. Importantly, 25 rural women have been employed as mentors, ensuring community engagement and empowerment.

Higher Education Scholarship Program

In higher education, over 900 students have received long-term support - not just financial assistance, but career mentoring, emotional support, and values coaching.



The Super 60 Program

The **'Super 60'** program, a residential coaching initiative for bright students from Government schools, prepares them for competitive exams and integrated courses. This program alone has transformed the trajectories of over 450 students in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana for the past 5 years. The results are amazing and inspiring.

Empowering rural youth and women to become economically independent is another cornerstone of abhaya's mission. Through skill development courses ranging from car driving and electrical wiring to tailoring and handicrafts, more than 18,000 families have found sustainable livelihoods. What makes abhaya unique is its holistic approach - it doesn't stop at training. Beneficiaries are equipped with tools, confidence, and a supportive ecosystem to succeed.

Enlightenment - Spreading Awareness for a Better Tomorrow



Under the **'Breathing Bharath'** initiative, abhaya has conducted thousands of awareness campaigns enlightening more than one Million people - from life skills, motivation, counseling, hygiene, health, and sanitation to financial literacy and moral values. These programs are not top-down lectures, but community-driven sessions that empower people to make informed choices.

'abhaya Bhavita', another thoughtful initiative aimed at teaching safety techniques to young girls across 1000 schools reaching out 5,00,000 students in the span of 2 years through posters, workshops, and interactive literature.

Relief & Rehabilitation - Serving at Ground Zero

abhaya has always answered the call in times of crisis. From the floods of Andhra Pradesh and Kerala to the earthquake in Nepal and the COVID-19 pandemic, its volunteers were among the first responders. During COVID, in partnership with the Telangana City Police and others, it served over one million meals and support kits to distressed families.

With campaigns like **'Hunt the Winter'** and **'Hunt the Summer'**, abhaya has distributed more than 1,10,000 blankets and 10,000 umbrellas to homeless individuals, elderly, and roadside vendors. These may seem like small gestures - but for the people who receive them, they are lifesaving.

abhaya - Campuses



abhaya's campuses stand as physical embodiments of its vision:

Home of Happiness, Hyderabad: A 16,000 sq. ft. facility housing destitute individuals, offering food, shelter, care, and dignity. Further serve uneducated, unemployed, rural youth of Telangana through their skill development center.

abhaya Yuva Empowerment Campus, Bangalore: A 3,000 sq. ft. training center transforming lives through skill-building. More than 50 rural children are being educated and empowered by Kamakoti Nadaswara Pathasala at the campus.

abhaya CCL Empowerment Campus, Anantapuram: A 20,000 sq. ft. hub for rural youth empowerment and community development.

abhaya Ranga Learning Center, Secunderabad: A dedicated center where hundreds of poor women are given livelihood skills and live skills.

abhaya Center for Empowerment (ACE), Shamshabad: A 20,000 sq. ft. campus is being built by Ramesh Gelli Foundation Hyderabad with an aim to empower thousands of rural youth in Telangana.
